General Statement of Policy

It is the policy of Earthwork Support Specialist (CE) Limited to comply with the terms of the Health & Safety at Work etc. Act 1974 and subsequent legislation. The Board of Directors have approved that its operations are executed at all times in such a way as to ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, the health, safety and welfare of all its employees and all persons likely to be affected by its operations, including subcontractors, visitors and the public where appropriate. The Board of Directors of ESS (CE) Limited believe that every employee has a responsibility for Health & Safety within the provisions of the Health & Safety at Work etc. Act 1974. It is therefore incumbent on all employees and sub-contractors to take reasonable care for their own safety and the safety of any others who may be affected by their acts or omissions. It is also essential for employees to co-operate with the Management of ESS (CE) Limited in its arrangements to perform or comply with statutory safety obligations which includes adherence to the Safety Policy, which should be read in conjunction with the Health & Safety at Work etc. Act 1974.

The specific arrangements for the implementation of this policy and the personnel responsible are detailed in the ESS (CE) Limited Health & Safety Policy Manual.

Employees will be properly trained and held accountable for following all prescribed safety procedures and practices. Health and Safety issues must not be compromised in order to achieve any other objective. Each employee is responsible for their own personal safety and the environment in which they work. No job will be considered so important, and no schedule so urgent, that time cannot be taken to perform work in a safe manner. Working safely is a condition of employment.

The Health & Safety Adviser working within ESS (CE) Limited is tasked with assisting management in achieving their Health and Safety objectives. They will provide management with analysis, assist management in developing and implementing effective safety procedures and will design the methods to effectively measure safety performance. They will also analyse results and make continuous recommendations in order to improve performance.
